

Charming Circular Napkins

Designed by Pat Baron for Pacific Fabrics & Crafts

Materials & Tools Needed for 6 Napkins:

Olfa Circle Cutter (not a must, but a really cool tool!)
7/8 yard each of two coordinating fabrics OR
1-5/8 yard of one fabric
Matching thread



Instructions:

Make a 13 inch circle pattern from card stock.

Using your pattern, cut out 12 circles of fabric right sides together. If you are using coordinating fabrics, cut 6 circles from each fabric.

Sew around each napkin with a seam the width of your presser foot, leaving a 2-3 inch opening for turning.

Clip notches in your seam allowance every 2 inches or so.

Turn your napkin to the right side pulling the seam flat.

Press and turn the unfinished seam allowances at the opening to the inside.

Finish the opening with either a blind stitch by hand (this is my preferred method) or topstitch around the napkin $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the edge catching the opening in your stitches.

Hints: These are fabulous in holiday fabrics and great fun to make in any theme. Try stitching some up in kid friendly prints for a birthday party and let the kids tie them up with ribbons to make a little sack for take home candy.



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
