

Leah's Luxurious Curves Scarf

This beautiful scarf has a reversible cable pattern that looks equally gorgeous on either side. The cables also make it a thick scarf, so it's cozy warm.

You will need:

Worsted Weight Yarn – about 300 yards. (Example used three balls of Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Aran)

Size 9 knitting needles

Cable needle

Glossary of terms:

CO: Cast on K: Knit P: Purl BO: Bind Off

C8F: Slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle, hold in front, K2,P2, then K2, P2 from cable needle.

C8B: Slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle, hold in back, K2,P2, then K2, P2 from cable needle.

Directions:

Cast on 40 stitches.

Rows 1-9: K2, P2

Row 10: K2, P2, C8F four times, K2, P2

Rows 11-19: K2, P2

Row 20: C8B five times (Warning: first set likes to twist. Be careful not to let it!)

Repeat this 20 row pattern until scarf is at desired length – end on row 19 of pattern, then BO all stitches.

Work in yarn ends, then enjoy the many compliments you receive in your gorgeous new scarf!
