

Burlap Wreath

Materials

1 Wire Coat Hanger
2 yards of Burlap
Assorted Embellishments
(ribbon, ornaments, buttons,
etc.)

To Make Your Wreath

1. Cut at least eight 8" strips of burlap across the width of the fabric.
2. Fringe both long edges of each strip leaving about 1-1/2 to 2" unfringed in the center of each strip.
3. Cut off the hook part of the coat hanger so that you can open it.
4. Running the coat hanger through the unfringed length of the burlap strips , weave your strips onto the wire coat hanger until you have the wreath as full as you would like it.
5. Re-twist the wire hanger ends together and add a wire or ribbon to make a hanger at the top of the wreath.
6. Add a bow and/or embellish the wreath with other pretties as you wish.



These make great gifts and are easy enough for a child to make. Have fun with the embellishments and think about making one for every season. Enjoy!
