

Button-Covered Candles

Materials:

Buttons Galore or Dara button bags

(colors of your choice)

Pillar candles (square or round)

E-6000 glue

Craft sticks



Instructions:

Since you will be gluing, be sure to protect your work surface before you begin.

1. Open your buttons and lay them out.
2. Get out your candle and glue. Be certain to follow the instructions on the glue.
3. Select random sizes of buttons and apply glue to the candle in small areas (about 1-2 inches wide and as high as you want). Be generous with the glue.
4. Apply buttons one at a time until the area with the glue is filled in, making peaks and valleys as you go. Use the craft sticks to move the buttons around and press them into place. You can also use them to spread the glue on the candle.
5. Let each section set up so as not to disturb the buttons when you apply the next section.

Tips:

- On a square candle, you can apply buttons one side at a time and then let dry (24hours).
- Make sure your buttons do not go below the bottom edge of your candle.
