FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 8" x 8"

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 54½" x 54½"

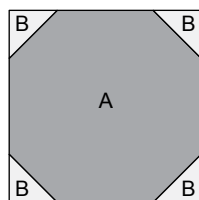
- A separate materials list is given for each of the two quilts.
- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

Materials: Multicolor Quilt

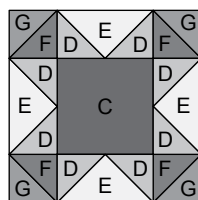
- 1 yd. Multicolor Quotes (2MUS1) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Multicolor Daisies (5MUS1) for blocks
- ⅝ yd. Multicolor Linear Floral (3MUS1) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Multicolor Birds (4MUS1) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Multicolor Vines (6MUS1) for blocks
- ¼ yd. Coral Umbels (7MUS1) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Green Umbels (7MUS3) for blocks
- ¼ yd. Blue Umbels (7MUS4) for blocks
- ½ yd. Yellow Umbels (7MUS2) for blocks and inner border
- 2¼ yds. Multicolor Large Floral (1MUS1) for outer border and binding
- 3¾ yds. for backing

Materials: Pink Quilt

- 1 yd. Pink Quotes (2MUS2) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Pink Daisies (5MUS2) for blocks
- ⅝ yd. Pink Linear Floral (3MUS2) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Pink Birds (4MUS2) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Pink Vines (6MUS2) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Pink Umbels (7MUS5) for blocks and inner border
- 2¼ yds. Pink Large Floral (1MUS2) for outer border and binding
- 3¾ yds. for backing

Cutting

One set of cutting instructions is given, and can be used for either of the two quilts. Fabrics are cut in order given in Materials lists. Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Quotes, cut:

- 12 squares, 8½" x 8½", for A squares

From Daisies, cut:

- 13 squares, 5¼" x 5¼"; cut each square twice diagonally to make 52 of triangle E
- 48 squares, 2½" x 2½", for B pieces (A stitch-and-flip technique will be used.)

From Linear Floral, cut:

- 13 squares, 4½" x 4½", for C squares

From Birds, cut:

- 26 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 52 of triangle F

From Vines, cut:

- 26 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 52 of triangle G

From Coral Umbels (Multicolor Quilt only), cut:

- 12 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 24 of triangle D

From Green Umbels (Multicolor Quilt only), cut:

- 16 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 32 of triangle D

From Blue Umbels (Multicolor Quilt only), cut:

- 12 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 24 of triangle D

From Yellow Umbels (Multicolor Quilt only), cut:

- 5 strips, 1½" x 40", for inner border
- 12 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 24 of triangle D

From Pink Umbels (Pink Quilt only), cut:

- 5 strips, 1½" x 40", for inner border
- 52 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 104 of triangle D

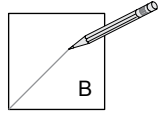
From Large Floral, cut in order given:

- 6 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding
- 4 lengthwise strips, 6½" x 57", for outer border (Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

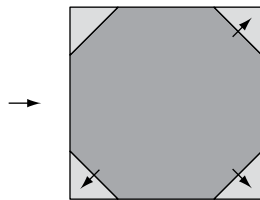
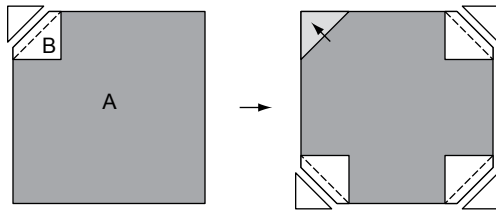
Block Assembly

All seams $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Assembly instructions are the same for both quilts. Refer to photographs for fabric placement.

- Using a pencil and ruler, draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of the 48 Daisies $2\frac{1}{2}$ " B squares.

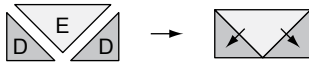


- With right sides together, place one of the marked B squares in one corner of a Quotes $8\frac{1}{2}$ " A square, being careful to orient it as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim as shown, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam toward triangle. Repeat technique on remaining three corners of A square. Then repeat entire step to make a total of 12 Snowball blocks.



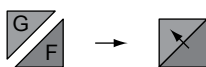
Make 12.

- Using 1 Daisies E triangle, and 2 matching-color Umbels D triangles, assemble a triangle unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 52 units. (For the Multicolor quilt, you should make 12 units with Coral Umbels, 16 units with Green Umbels, 12 units with Blue Umbels, and 12 units with Yellow Umbels.)



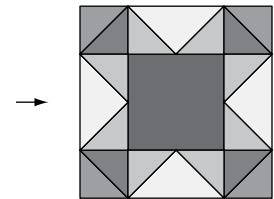
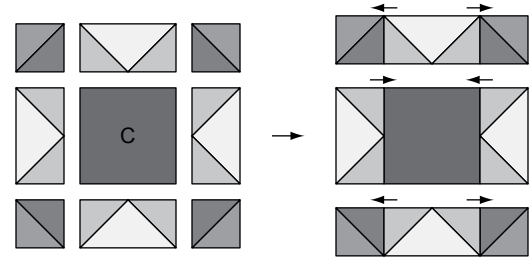
Make 52.

- Using 1 Birds F triangle, and 1 Vines G triangle, assemble a triangle unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 52 units.

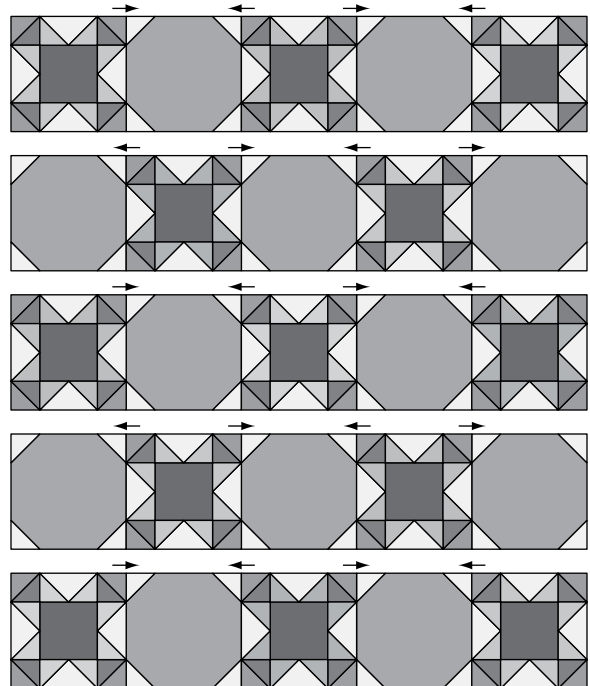
- Using a Linear Floral $4\frac{1}{2}$ " C square, 4 matching triangle units from Step 3, and 4 triangle units from Step 4, assemble a Star block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 13 blocks.

Quilt Top Assembly

- Sew the Snowball blocks and Star blocks together in rows as shown.



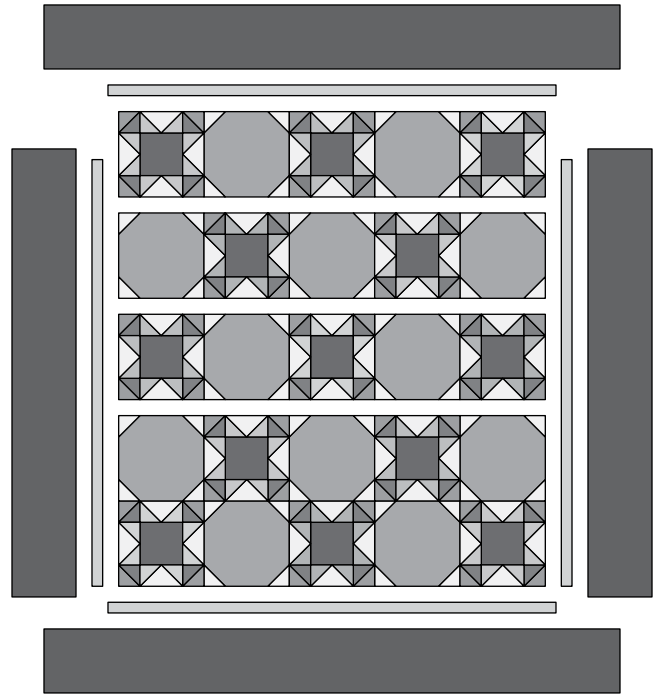
- Sew rows together as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram on back page. Press seams toward rows with three Snowball blocks.

Borders

1. Sew the 5 inner border strips together, end-to-end, to make one long strip. Press seams open.
2. Measure length of quilt top through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward inner borders.
3. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
4. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.
5. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim remaining 2 outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
