

Cabled Headband and Mitts

Cherub Chunky

Knitting Pattern C268 - Intermediate

Materials:

- Cascade Yarns® Cherub Chunky: 55% nylon / 45% acrylic, 100g (3.5oz) - 136.7 yds (125 m); 2 skeins color #25 Ruby
- Size 9 US / 5.5mm needles
- Cable Needle

Gauge:

20 ½ stitches and 19 rows in 4 inches/10cm
in cable pattern

Notes:

When the instructions indicate to “work stitches as presented”, then knit the knit stitches



Abbreviations:

c6f inc 2- slip 3 stitches onto the cable needle and hold in front of the work. K1, kfb twice, then k3 from cable needle.

c8f inc 2- slip 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of the work. K2, kfb twice, then k4 from cable needle.

c10f inc 2- slip 5 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of the work. K3, kfb twice, then k5 from cable needle.

c12f - slip 6 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of the work. K6, then k6 from cable needle.

c10f dec2 - slip 5 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of the work. K3, k2tog twice, then k5 from cable needle.

c8f dec2 - slip 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of work. K2, k2tog twice, then k4 from cable needle.

c6f dec2- slip 3 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of work. K1, k2tog twice, then k3 from cable needle.

k2tog - knit 2 together

kfb - knit into the front of the stitch leaving the loop on left hand needle, then complete an entire knit stitch into the back of the same stitch. This is a one stitch increase.

pbf - purl into the back of the stitch leaving the loop on left hand needle, then complete an entire purl stitch into the front of the same stitch. This is a one stitch increase



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and purl the purl stitches

Cabled Headband Pattern: Cast on 14

Rows 1, 3, 5: p3, k1, p6, k1, p3. WS

Rows 2, 4: k3, p1, k6, p1, k3. RS

Row 6: k3, pbf, k6, pbf, k3. 16 sts.

Rows 7-11: work stitches as presented.

Row 12: k3, p2, c6f inc 2, p2, k3. 18 sts.

Rows 13, 15, 17: p3, k2, p8, k2, p3.

Rows 14, 16: k3, p2, k8, p2, k3.

Row 18: k3, p1, pbf, k8, pbf, p1, k3. 20 sts.

Rows 19-23: work stitches as presented.

Row 24: k3, p3, c8f inc 2, p3, k3. 22 sts.

Rows 25-31: work stitches as presented.

Row 32: k3, p2, pbf, k10, pbf, p2, k3. 24 sts.

Rows 33-37: work stitches as presented.

Row 38: k3, p4, c10f inc 2, p4, k3. 26 sts.

Rows 39-45: work stitches as presented.

Row 46: k3, p3, pbf, k12, pbf, p3, k3. 28 sts.

Rows 47-51: work stitches as presented.

Row 52: k3, p5, c12f, p5, k3.

Rows 53-57: work stitches as presented.

Row 58: k3, p3, p2tog, k12, p2tog, p3, k3. 26 sts.

Rows 59-65: work stitches as presented.

Row 66: k3, p4, c10f dec 2, p4, k3. 24 sts.

Rows 67-71: work stitches as presented.

Row 72: k3, p2, p2tog, k10, p2tog, p2, k3. 22 sts

Rows 73-79: work stitches as presented.

Row 80: k3, p3, c8f dec 2, p3, k3 20 sts.

Rows 81-85: work stitches as presented .

Row 86: k3, p1, p2tog, k8, p2tog, p1, k3. 18 sts.

Rows 87-91: work stitches as presented

Row 92: k3, p2, c6f dec2, p2, k3. 16 sts.

Rows 93-97: work stitches as presented.

Row 98: k3, p2tog, k6, p2tog, k3. 14 sts.

Rows 99-103: work stitches as presented.

Bind off in pattern. Sew cast on edge to bind off edge.
Work in ends and block lightly.

Cabled Mitts Pattern: Cast on 36. Join to work in the round

Rounds 1-9, 11-23, 25-27: p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2.

Round 10, 24: p2, k2, p2, c8f, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, c8f, p2 k2.

Begin Thumb Gusset:

Round 28: p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p1, pm, m1l, pm, p1, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2.

Round 29: p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p1, sm, k1, sm, p1, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2.

Round 30: p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p1, sm, m1l, k1, m1r, sm p1, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2. (increase round)

Round 31: p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p1, sm, k3, sm p1, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2.

Repeat rounds 30 and 31, increasing 2 stitches between the markers on the increase rounds until there 9 stitches between the markers.

Round 38: p2, k2, p2, c8f, p2, k2, p1, place 9 thumb gusset stitches on a holder to work later, p1, k2, p2, c8f, p2, k2.

Rounds 39-46: p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2
Bind off in pattern.

Thumb:

Slip the 9 thumb gusset stitches on 2 double point needles.

With a 3rd needle, pick up 3 stitches along inside of the thumb.

Work in the round for 4 rounds, then bind off.
