Size & Finished Measurements: 18 1/2" wide x 61" long

Materials:

- Cascade Yarns[®] Sarasota
 60% Cotton /
 40% Acrylic;
 100 g (3.5 oz) /
 314 yds (287.5 m)
- 5 skeins of color #212 (Molten Lava)
- Crochet hook size G (4.25 mm)
- Yarn needle







Sarasota



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Gauge:

13 sts x 7 rows = 4" (10 cm) Unblocked, in dc Stitch

Abbreviations:

bptr	= back post treble crochet
ch	= chain stitch
ch sp	= chain space
dc	= double crochet
fptr	= front post treble crochet
hdc	= half double crochet
lp(s)	= loop(s)
rep	= repeat
SC	= single crochet
sk	= skip
sl st	= slip stitch
sp	= space
tr	= treble crochet
уо	= yarn over

Special Stitches:

Back post treble crochet cluster (bptrcl) Pattern Stitch: Directions: Yo twice, insert hook around post of closest fptr to your right, (draw new lp through 2 lps on hook) twice, yo twice, insert hook around post of next fptr to your left, (draw new lp through 2 lps on hook) 3 times

Pattern Notes:

First ch 3 counts as first dc throughout. Always work dc stitches in dc stitches, never in a fptr or bptrcl.

To help diamonds keep their shape, you can work some post sts through the post of the st you are working in, instead of around it.

Begin Pattern: Ch 68

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across; ch 3, turn. 65 dc

Row 2: RS * Sk next dc, work fptr around next dc, working behind fptr, dc in skipped dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, fptr in same st as last fptr, dc in next dc; rep from * across; ch 3, turn. 65 dc, 32 fptr







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Row 3: (Sk fptr, dc in next dc, work bptrcl, dc in each of next 2 dc, sk fptr, dc in next dc) across; ch 3, turn. 65 dc, 16 bptrcl

Row 4: * Sk next 2 dc, work fptr around tip of bptrcl, working behind fptr, dc in each skipped dc, dc in next dc, fptr in same st as last fptr, dc in next dc; rep from * across; ch 3, turn.

Rows 5-121. Rep rows 3-4; rep row 3; ch 1, turn.

Row 122: Sc in each dc across, skipping each bptrcl; turn to work down long side. 65 sc

Edging

Sc evenly around shawl, working (sc, ch 1, sc) in each corner; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

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
