
# DK729 Heritage 6 Serene Shawl

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# **Finished Measurements:**

20" wide x 68 long

## Materials:

- Cascade Yarns<sup>®</sup> Heritage 6; 75% Superwash Merino Wool/ 25% nylon; 100 g (3.5 oz)/ 292 yds (262 m);
- 6 skeins color #5704 (Dusty Turquoise)
- US F (3.75 mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle


## Gauge:

9 sts x 7 rows = 2'' (5 cm) Blocked, in hdc stitch Pattern

## **Abbreviations:**

ch	= chain stitch
ch sp	= chain space
dc	= double crochet
RS	= right side of work
sk	= skip
sp	= space

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# Special Stitches:

Shell = [(dc, ch 1) 3 times, dc] in specified st

Notes:

Shawl is worked from the center out.

First ch 4 counts as first dc, ch 1.

First ch 5 counts as first dc, ch 2.

## **Begin Pattern:**

First Half

Ch 98

Row 1: RS Dc in 6<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) across; ch 1, turn. 47 ch sps

Row 2: WS Sc in first dc, (sc in next ch sp, work shell in next ch sp) across, sc in last ch sp, sc in last dc; ch 1, turn. 23 shells, 27 sc

Row 3: Sc in first sc, sl st in next sc, [sc in next sp of shell, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next (center) sp of shell, sc in next sp of shell, sl st in next sc] across, sc in last sc; ch 5, turn. 23 ch 2 sps

Row 4: (Sc in ch 2 sp, ch 3) across, sc in last ch 2 sp, ch 2, dc in last st; ch 1, turn. 22 ch 3 sps, 2 ch 2 sps, 2 dc

Row 5: Hdc in first dc, 2 hdc in next ch sp, (hdc in next sc, 3 hdc in next ch sp) across to last sc, hdc in last sc, 2 hdc in last ch sp, hdc in last ch sp; ch 1, turn. 95 hdc

Row 6: Sc in each st across; ch 4, turn. 95 sc

Row 7: (Sk next st, dc in next st, ch 1) across, turn. 47 ch sps

Rows 8-111: Rep rows 2-7 17 times. Rep rows 2-3 once. Fasten off.





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#### Second Half

With RS facing, join yarn on opposite side of foundation ch to work second half.

Row 1: Ch 4, sk next ch, dc in next ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) across. 47 ch sps

Rows 2-111: Rep rows 2-7 of First Half 18 times. Rep rows 2-3 once. Fasten off.

Shell Edging (work 2)

With WS facing, join yarn in end of first sc to work across long side of shawl.

Row 1: (Work shell in end of next dc row, sk next sc row, sc in next hdc row, work shell in end of next dc row, sk next sc row, sc in end of next sc row) 18 times, sk next dc row, work shell in side of center foundation ch, sk next dc row and sc row, sc in next sc row; rep between ()s across rem side of shawl; ch 1, turn. 73 shells

Row 2: (Sc in next sp of shell, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next center sp of shell, sc in next sp of shell, sl st in next sc) across. Fasten off.

#### Finishing

Weave in ends; block.
