




Strawberry Lace Scarf & Hat

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Materials: Cascade Yarn's Pacific® (40% Superwash

Merino Wool / 60% Acrylic), 3.5 oz., 213 yds.

2 skeins for scarf, 1 skein for hat

Crochet hooks, G & H, yarn needle

Size: Scarf: 60" x 9" approx. blocked

Hat: woman's band circumference 21" -22"

with some give.

Abbreviations

Ch = chain	Sc = single crochet	Dc = double crochet	St = stitch
Sk – skip	Sp = space	SI st = slip stitch	Rep = repeat
Rnd = round			

Sc dec = single crochet decrease: Draw up a loop in next two stitches, (three loops on hook) yarn over and pull through all three loops.

SCARF

The scarf is constructed in two pieces seamed together at the center so the ends look similar.

With size H hook, ch 38.

Row 1: SC in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 3, sk next 5 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch, ch 3, sk next 5 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, (counts as dc), 2 dc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next ch-3 loop, (sc, ch3) in each of next 3 ch-1 spaces, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, sk next ch-3 loop**, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next sc; rep from * ending last rep at **, 3 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, (counts as dc), 2 dc in first dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-1 space, (sc, ch 3) in each of next 2 ch-3 loops, sc in next ch-3 loop, ch 2, sk next ch-1 space**, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1 space; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, skip next 2 dc, 3 dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in first dc, *ch 3, sk next ch-2 space, (sc, ch 3) in each of next 2 ch-3 loops, sk next ch-2 space**, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1 space; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first dc, *ch 3, sk next ch-3 loop, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-3 loop, sk next ch-3 loop, sc in next ch-1 space, rep from * across, ending with last sc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Repeat Rows 2-5 for pattern 14 times, then work Rows 2-4 once more. End off.

Repeat above for 2nd half.

Sew starting edges together for the center back.

Wet block to measurements and let dry completely.

HAT

For smaller band, use size G hook, for larger band use size H hook. Ch 84, join being careful not to twist the chain. Ch 1


Work 5 rnds continuously now without joining, increasing to 96 on last rnd. Join with sl st.

Change to size H hook.

Begin pattern rnds:

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in 1^{st} sc, *ch 3, sk next 5 sc, (dc, ch1, dc, ch1, dc, ch1, dc, ch1, dc) in 6^{th} sc, ch 3, sk 5 sc, sc in next sc* ch 3. End last rep by joining to 1^{st} sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, (counts as 1 dc) dc in joining, ch 1, 2 dc in same place, *ch 1, (sc, ch 3) in next 3 ch-1 spaces, sc in next ch 1 space, ch 1, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next sc* rep bet *'s, 6 more times, ch 1, (sc, ch 3) in next 3 ch 1 spaces, ch 1, join to top of 1st ch 3.



Rnd 4: SI st over to next ch-1 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in ch-1 space, ch 3, (sc, ch 3) in next ch 3 sp, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, *2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, (sc, ch3) in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3* rep from *, sI st in top of beg ch 3.

Rnd 5: SI st over to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in same place, *ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, dc in same sp) 4 times, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp (between 2 dc groups) * rep bet *'s 6 more times, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, (dc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, dc in same sp) 4 times, ch 3, join to 1st sc.

Rep rows 2-5 for 3 more times, then rnds 2-4 once more. (about 9" from beg).

Crown:

Rnd 1: SI st over to next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in same space, *work 3 sc in each ch-3 space and 1 sc in each ch-1 space around. Do not join.

Work sc decreases around and around until there are about 4 sts left. Cut yarn, leaving long tail and run in and out of remaining stitches. Pull up to close hole and secure.

Weave in all ends.
