



Garment 303: Jeans Intermediate/Advanced

Finding a pair of jeans that fits you well is a common struggle and once you finally do, styles change, manufacturers tweak the fit and you have to start your search all over. Let's put our sewing skills to the task and learn how to make our own! Hardware and topstitching are crucial to achieve that authentic jeans look and we will go over the steps in detail to ensure you are comfortable with the process and understand all the fiddly little details. Many of these steps shouldn't be rushed and include tools that you may not normally keep in your sewing tool box such as a hammer.

Fit is always important, especially with pants, so we will start off the first day of class sewing a test version to try on and see if any adjustments are needed to be made to the pattern to fit you better. Once we're satisfied with the fit, we will start working on our final versions confident that when completed our jeans will look amazing.

Prerequisite: Garment 204: Flat Front Pants or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- Pattern (Pick one)
 - Closet Core Morgan Jeans
 - Thread Theory Jedediah pants
 - Thread Theory Quadra Jeans
 - True Bias Lander Pant & Short
- Fabric
 - See pattern for fabric suggestions and required yardage.
 - **Please make sure to PREWASH and IRON your fabric prior to class.**
 - Purchase the same amount of muslin as you would your fashion fabric
 - It is **NOT** necessary to prewash your muslin as it will only be used for testing purposes and not for actual wear.
- Hardware
 - Jeans hardware kits purchased in store are compatible with our handpress to ease installation. Kits bought elsewhere may not be and will require more muscle to install.
- Denim needles
- Matching thread
 - As nice as contrast top stitching thread is, that gold colored thread will show off every wobble and drastically increase the difficulty level. Matching topstitching thread is also common and much more forgiving while making your first pair(s) of jeans.

Please take your measurements and cut out your **pattern and muslin** ahead of the first day of class. If you would like to preserve your pattern to make additional sizes later, we have Swedish Tracing paper available instore you can trace your pattern onto.

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. Sewing Machines: If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.

Pets are not allowed in the classroom or store, service animals are allowed while they are working.
