

# SEWING PATTERN #6 - Flat / Stash Pouch- by Splash Fabric

Pencils, Tape | Snacks | Cords | Feminine products | Ditties | Paraphernalia | Toothbrush, shaver, chapstick | Tools of all trades | Travel

Perfect for your phone, school supplies, essential oils, make-up, art stuff, loose cords. This cute, waterproof pouch zips it up. If you knit or craft, this is the bag you want for the special stoppers, bobbers and snippers. What will you put in yours?

Finished size - 8.5" w x 4.5" h

Warning: these pouches are addictive. I suggest you make this one first and then you can scale them up, make them taller, shorter.

**Durable & Long-Lasting** 

Water-based urethane laminated cotton CPSIA certified, BPA & Phthalate-free, food-safe and earth-safe. Wipe clean with damp cloth, scrub stains on back side. Machine wash warm okay, hang dry, iron low.

#### **Sewing Notes**


RS = Right Sides, RST = Right Sides Together
Fear not: Sewing with laminated cotton is easier than it looks.
Standard or heavy thread and Denim needle work well.
Needle suggestion: SCHMETZ NonStick size 100 or Denim needle
Use a longer than normal stitch length.
No need to bind or serge cut edges. Fabric won't unravel - it's sealed / laminated

### Materials

Fabric: 2 10" x 10" pieces of fabric- 1 for inside, 1 for outside. Splash Fabric laminated cotton fabric is perfect! If you pick a fabric with a 1-way print, be sure to sew so images are upright on the front. Our fabric is multi-directional, so no need to worry.

- 18" of 1 side of #5 coil zipper tape, 1 #5 zipper pull. I use black.
- 3" webbing. I use 3/4" nylon. Can be wider, narrower, cotton... (or whatever you have).
- 1" back plastic ring. (You can also use any clip or key hook you can find.)





# Cut

1. Cut 2 squares  $10^{\prime\prime}$  x  $10^{\prime\prime}$  - Cut 1 of 2 different prints. 1 for the front, 1 for the back.

Our fabrics are 58" wide. Our prints are multi-directional.

2. Place 2 fabrics (Wrong Sides Together - so Right sides are showing on both sides.)

## Sew

- 3. Choose Right Sides of Pouch what you want on the outside fold in half. The fold will be the bottom of the bag. Stitch one side of pouch. ("side seam")
- 4. Pull zipper apart.
- 5. Pin or clip zipper tape along top of pouch on the inside. Be sure bumpy side of zipper faces Right Side ('outside") of pouch.

Stitch zipper on all around the top of the bag.

6. Cut ends of zipper so 1 side is long, cut 1 side diagonally so that end of coil is lined up with end of outside fabric.

This is the only tricky part of making our pouches. Once you get it, you will be hooked!

- 7. Feed zipper pull onto long side first, then onto the angled cut side. This takes patience! It's ok to do it over until you get the edges of the right sides lined up so the pouch squares up well. Get it straight, or the pouch will twist.
- 8. Fold webbing over the hoop or ring. Heat seal the ends of the nylon with a lighter or match. Pin to the side of the pouch near the top.
- 9. Stitch last open side closed with the, double stitching zipper end. (Optional bind with 1" binding tape or ribbon. No need to bind because our fabric is sealed by the laminate.)
- 10. Turn inside out. Fill with anything you can think of. Enjoy!
