



## Knits 201B: Basic Tee Advanced Beginner

Everyone needs a basic tee in their wardrobe and there's nothing better when you've made it yourself to fit exactly how you like it. Unfortunately, knits have gotten a bad reputation for being difficult to work with or needing special equipment – not true. We will go over how to make a t-shirt on the sewing machine, learning how to read and follow a pattern along the way. We will also cover sizing, adjusting the pattern if needed, plus tips and tricks to make working with knits easier.

This class teaches similar skills as our Knits 201A: Raglan Sweatshirt class (formerly Knits 201: Sweatshirt/Tee) however instead of a raglan sleeve, the patterns feature a traditional set in or drop sleeve and is meant specifically for T-shirt weight fabrics.

*Prerequisite: Sewing 101 or equivalent experience.*

**Supplies:** Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. **Sewing Machines:** If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.
