

Upcycling 201: T-Shirt Wrap Skirt Advanced Beginner

If you ever wondered, "What should I do with all these graphic t-shirts that I still like, but no longer wear?" They can be transformed into a new garment that will give them new life. The act of creating something new out of something old can be a rewarding experience, keeping your garments out of the landfills and saving you money. All you need is 6-8 graphic t-shirts to upcycle and a few basic sewing supplies. If you do not have t-shirts to upcycle already in your stash, consider rescuing some from a secondhand shop.

Upcycling the process of reusing discarded objects or materials in such a way as to create a product of higher quality or value than the original.

Prerequisite: Knits 201A/201B or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- 6-8 graphic t-shirts to cut up and use as fabric.
 - It is best to choose t-shirts of similar weight and in colors that you like together.
 - 6 t-shirts will be the minimum that you will need if you are a larger size, please bring 8 t-shirts.
 - o Clothing **MUST** be clean! Dirty clothes will not be worked on.
- ½ yard of knit fusible interfacing
 - o If you are unsure what interfacing is appropriate, we will go over that in more detail during class.
- Matching and/or contrast thread.
 - This can be a fun project to experiment with contrast stitching, so consider bringing a fun contrast thread color for topstitching.

You will receive a 20% discount on your class supplies when you show your registration receipt.

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. The Class Supply List is available online on the calendar item for each class. Please download and print the list when you register. Sewing Machines: If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order, and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.

Pets are not allowed in the classroom or store, service animals are allowed while they are working.
