



Garment 219: Quilted Vest Intermediate

Are you a garment maker who's curious about quilting but not ready to dive in headfirst? Or maybe you're a quilter who has too many quilts and is looking for another way to display your piecing? Quilted vests are a wonderful way to combine both arts to create a truly unique garment without feeling overwhelmed with new techniques. Depending on your skill background, you can include a quilt block, piecing or yardage.

If you've never quilted before, the easiest way to start is by using yardage with a fun print. You will learn the basics of making a "quilt sandwich" and sewing all the layers together.

If you've done some quilting, you can incorporate a quilt block into the back of your vest. Vest size will determine how large a block you can use, but it should be about 8-12 inches finished.

If you've done a lot of quilting, you can piece larger sections such as the pockets or even the entire vest.

Prerequisite: Garment 201 PJ Pants or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- Fabric & Notions
 - See pattern for fabric suggestions and required yardage.
- Batting
 - We will go over the different kinds batting in to help you decide what type to use.
- Cotton thread
 - For construction and quilting all the layers together.

Please take your measurements and **cut out your pattern pieces ahead of class**. If your back vest piece is "place on fold," I recommend you trace out a full piece. This will allow you to center a quilt block or design more easily.

If you would like to preserve your pattern to make additional sizes later, we have Swedish Tracing paper available instore you can trace your pattern onto.

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store.
