



Sewing 209: Splash Apron Advanced Beginner/Intermediate

An apron is a must to keep your clothes clean during messy activities such as cooking, crafting or gardening. An even better apron will keep any liquids from soaking through. Learn how to make a quick and easy apron using Splash Fabric's laminated cotton which combines a cotton base with a fun print and a waterproof, non-toxic and food safe coating. We will use bias binding to finish the raw edges for a nice clean finish.

Prerequisite: Sewing 101 or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- Pattern
 - Splash Fabrics Adult or Kid apron
 - Available on our website under "Free Projects"
 - You will receive a printed version in class
- Fabric
 - 1 yard Splash Fabrics laminated cotton
 - You will have enough for a second apron or another Splash project listed on our Free Projects page.
 - ½ yard quilting cotton for self-made bias binding
 - Enough for one apron (≈ 4 yards)
 - **OR** 2 packages of Wright's ½ inch wide double fold bias tape
- Thread
 - Choose a color that matches your bias binding

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. The Class Supply List is available online on the calendar item for each class. Please download and print the list when you register. Sewing Machines: If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.
