



Garment 305: Blazers Advanced

A blazer can elevate virtually any outfit regardless of what you're wearing underneath it. A blazer can take your "jeans and a t-shirt" outfit from casual to business and easily transitions from day to night. It conveys confidence and polish all wrapped up in a timeless garment. Naturally this is all amplified when you've made it yourself and it fits you perfectly.

During class while working on fit, cutting out all the pieces of outer fabric, lining, interfacing and usually even more interfacing(?!), you will learn how to construct your blazer and keep the entire process as streamlined and organized as possible. We will be focusing on speed tailoring and using fusible interfacing during construction. You will learn how to create sharp lapels and welt pockets, soft shawl collars and how to insert the lining depending on how much hand sewing you choose to do.

The format of this class is different from what we usually offer as it doesn't entirely happen on consecutive weeks to allow you additional time to complete your homework. Class is a total of 5 days plus a project consultation for over 25 hours of in-depth instruction. The first day will focus on altering your muslins to better fit you and transferring those changes back to the pattern pieces. During the remaining days we will work on your jackets.

Prerequisite: Permission of the instructor. Email erin@pacificfabrics.com to ensure you are at the correct skill level.

- Fabric & Notions

 - **Please make sure to PRETREAT and IRON your fabric prior to class.**
- Muslin
 - See pattern for fashion fabric yardage
- Matching thread

Please take your measurements and **cut out your pattern and muslin ahead of the first class**. I highly recommend tracing your pattern and working from that while we work on fit. We have pattern tracing paper available in store you can trace your pattern onto.

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store.
