



Holiday 102: Fabric Ornaments Beginner

Learn how to make beautiful and unique fabric ornaments with no sewing skills required! Using folded 2 ½" squares you will use pins to create detailed patterns. In class you will learn how to create two different patterns that you will be able to finish up at home. (You focus on half of an ornament at a time.)

This project is perfect for scraps, Fat Quarters and Jelly Rolls. Please keep in mind that solids or small patterns work best for this project – if a print is too large it will just look like large masses of color and will make the pattern you create more difficult to see.

Included in the class cost is a kit fee of \$5.00. The kit includes two 3" smooth Styrofoam balls which form the base of the ornaments and two hanging screws.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- 40 2 ½" squares each from 3 different fabrics
 - Solids and small prints work best
 - **Squares need to be cut out ahead of class!**
 - You should have a total of 120 squares
- Sequin pins – ½" (12mm)
- 18" minimum strip of 2 ½" wide fabric
 - Can substitute 1", 1 ½" or 2" wide ribbon

Optional

- Petite Pearlized pins – ¾" (19mm)
- Thimble
 - You will be pushing in a LOT of pins

You will receive a 20% discount on your class supplies when you show your registration receipt in store or use the webstore coupon code in your class email.

Refunds are not given in the case of student cancellation, but if you have paid for a class and are unable to attend, you may send a friend in your place. Please tell us the name of the friend taking your place prior to class. If you are unable to send a friend in your place, your class fees will be forfeited. Taxes: Due to changes in Washington State tax law (ESSB 5814) live presentations, including classes, are now subject to sales tax.

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. The Class Supply List is available online on the calendar item for each class. Please download and print the list when you register. You will receive a 20% discount on your class supplies when you show your registration receipt in store at the register while checking out.

Sewing Machines: If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.

Children and Pets: Children are not allowed in the classroom unless they are attending as a student in a class offered for children and may not be left unattended in the store while you are in class. Pets are not allowed in the classroom or store, service animals are allowed while they are working.
