



Sewing 303: Super Tote Intermediate

You'll love Noodlehead's Super Tote! The Super Tote is a generous sized tote bag that is perfect for hauling around anything you need and can make a perfect diaper bag or gym bag. It is a great way to enhance your bag making skills and includes features such as a recessed zipper, roomy interior pockets, and a front exterior pocket. It also has cute piping and pleat details.

Prerequisite: Sewing 102 or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- Noodlehead Super Tote Pattern
- ½ yard canvas or Home Dec fabric for front, back & exterior pocket*
 - **The cutting layout is VERY tight on 45" wide fabric. If you would like play with your pattern placement at all, **please purchase a full yard.***
- 1 yard quilting cotton for lining
 - 1 ½ if fully lining front pocket
- 2 ½ yard cuts for straps
 - 2 yards of 1 ½" wide webbing can be substituted
- ⅔ yard exterior gusset (includes interior pocket pieces)
- 2 ¼ yard Pellon SF101 fusible interfacing
- 1 yard Pellon Craft-Fuse 808/809 **OR** By Annie's Soft & Stable
 - ½ yard headliner can also be used
- 18" zipper for recessed top
 - Optional
- 1 yard of ¼" wide elastic
- 15" of ½" piping (handmade or storebought)
 - If making your own, fabric can be cut on the straight grain
- 14mm magnetic snap or 2 inches of ¾" wide Velcro
 - Optional
- Matching thread
- Size 14 or 16 denim needle

We have a lot to accomplish, so please cut out all your fabric and interfacing in advance. The pattern includes a cutting layout in case there are any questions how to cut your pieces

You will receive a 20% discount on your class supplies when you show your registration receipt.

Sewing Machines: If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.
